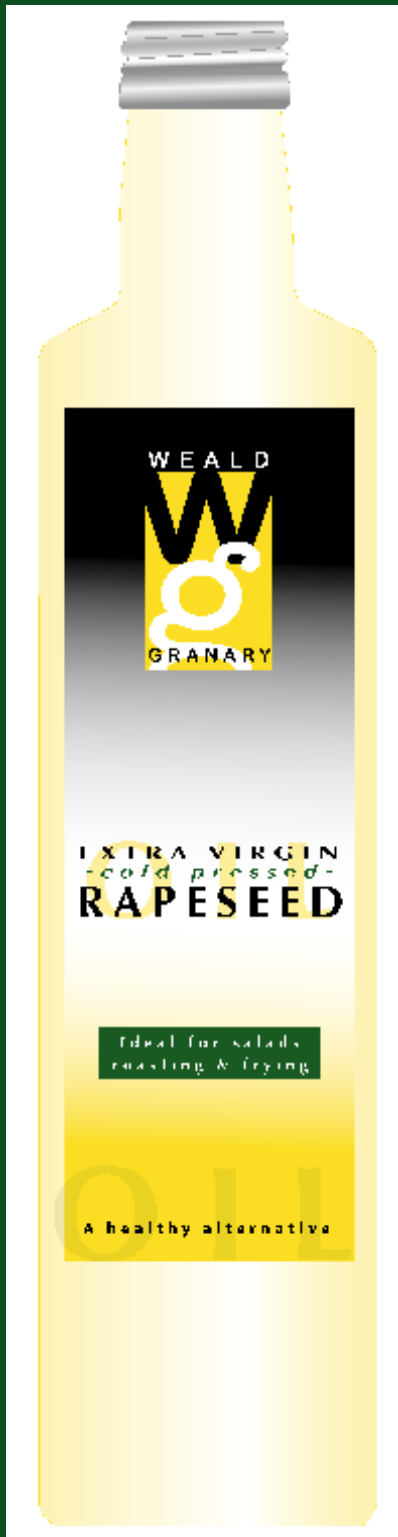

QUICK, GET THE CHEQUEBOOK OUT

The cost of a tonne of storage space at the Granary will rise to £110 as from the 1st of March. Due to rising costs this is the very least we can build the next stage of development for, and it would of course be bad economics to sell at a loss (farmers would never do that). The price includes a, currently theoretical, 40% grant from SEEDA which is accessible only because we are a co-operative.

On the one hand this means that, unless you want to get in quick, any future tonnage will cost more. On the other it means the value of the tonnage you already own is actually appreciating rather than depreciating.
